In February 1997, I organized a community leader's briefing attended by 120 community leaders including then CPS CEO **Paul Vallas** and former Chicago Bears and now NFL Hall of Famer, **Mike Singletary**. We made reference then to a U.S. Department of Education study indicating that when both parents are involved in the educational lives of their child, educational outcomes soar and many of the issues that plague society decline. You've known it all along that **GREATER FATHER INVOLVEMENT = GREATER STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT.** In October of this year I gave a TEDx Talk entitled: *Why We Need To Break The Cycle of Father Absence*. A special thank you to all who have previously participated. To-date and with the engagement of education leaders, like yourself, we've collected more than 400,000 essays from more than 500 schools, engaging well over 10,000 volunteer evaluators and annually recognizing 156 essayists in May and 12 dads each June. Remember, <u>every child is a winner</u> receiving a Certificate of Participation signed by the Governor and a coupon sheet with activities to further connect with dad.

We are pleased to be partnering with Illinois PTA to expand the reach of the essays contest. Here are the highlights for the 2017 essay contest.

- The top 25 participating schools will receive a Starter Kit of Fathering Resources,
- All dads who provide a "dad's response" to their child's essay will become charter members in the new *IFI 21st Century Dads Club*, and
- The deadline for submission is March 15, 2017.



#1 - CHECKLIST

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO FOLLOW THIS CHECKLIST STEP-BY-STEP FOR THE CONTEST TO RUN SMOOTHLY! THANKS FOR YOUR ATTENTION!

"What My Father Means To Me" is this year's theme for the essays. We guarantee every essay submitted will be read at least once if not multiple times. All students submitting an essay through their school will receive a Certificate of Participation and a coupon sheet, which includes discounts on events and merchandise, and specially priced Chicago White Sox tickets.

One hundred fifty-six (156) essay semi-finalists (12 per grade), their fathers/father figures, etc, will be invited to attend the May Faces of Fatherhood CelebrationTM as our guests. Twelve (12) of the essay finalists will be invited with their fathers to attend the **2017 IFI Fatherhood Dinner Celebration** taking place in June 2017 at Union League Club of Chicago. 4 essayists and their dads will also be invited to a future White Sox game and to throw out a pre-game ceremonial 1st pitch.

• THE TOP 25 PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS WILL EACH RECEIVE A STARTER KIT OF FATHERING RESOURCES.

• SCHOOLS WITH 100% PARTICIPATION WILL RECEIVE FURTHER RECOGNITION.

INSTRUCTION CHECKLIST:

1. Select One Contact Person. This person will be responsible for collecting all of the essays from your school, filling out the Submission Form and shipping the essays postmarked by March 15, 2017. Please have this contact person e-mail the following information – person's name, their e-mail address, school name, address, phone and fax number to: *4fathers.sneed@gmail.com* immediately so that we can establish communication throughout the Contest.

2. Photocopy and distribute Teacher & Classroom Form (Item #4) and Official Essay Contest Entry Forms (Item #5) to all K-12 grade level teachers. Please type the name of your school and school address on the form before making the copies. This will save time for your students and ensure proper identification of your school.

3. Allow ample time after the essays are written, prior to the contest deadline (March 15, 2017) for the father/father figure to respond and return completed Entry Form to each teacher.

4. Ask each teacher to make complete copies of the Entry Forms with essays prior to submitting so copies can be shared with all dads. Due to heavy volume, IFI is not able to return essays once they are submitted.

5. We want all essays to be read by our volunteers. It is necessary to have all essays written in English. Please translate the essay if not written in English.

6. Mail to: IFI/Chicago White Sox 2017 Fatherhood Essay Contest, 1 North Dearborn, #1000, Chicago, IL 60602. Postmark deadline for the contest is March 15, 2017. Place the completed School Submission Form on the top of all the Entry Forms. We encourage you to send in the essays prior to the deadline.

7. The judging will be done from March 20 to April 15, 2017. The 156 essay finalists will be notified shortly thereafter. The Certificates of Participation and Coupon Sheets will be distributed by May 15, 2017. If your school contact does not receive your school's awards by then, please let us know via email to *4fathers.sneed@gmail.com* with the subject line "Missing Awards". (NOTE: please do not phone in the missing awards).

#2 – FACT SHEET

Each student is asked to write a 250 word (or less) essay in English on the theme "What My Father Means To Me," describing their relationship with their father or father figure. They should share their true feelings. Provide examples of joys, frustrations or special memories they have as well as commenting about what they would most like to see in their relationship. Father figures can include: uncles, brothers, coaches, or other persons of influence to the student. Please be sure the correct category is checked on the essay form.

CRITERIA FOR ESSAY JUDGING:

Please stress to all students that all submissions will be evaluated according to grade level. Judging criteria will consist of:

- 1. How the essay describes the relationship.
- 2. Specific detail and stories that demonstrate Father's/Father-Figure's character.
- 3. Honesty, clarity, simplicity of writing.
- 4. Overall grade level appropriate writing skill.
- 5. The response of the Father/Father figure or other involved adult.

JUDGING PROCESS

1. Essays will be divided into 13 categories (K-12) and four divisions (fathers, grandfather, stepfather, and father-figure). Local volunteers will utilize the above judging criteria and read every essay. At the Final essay reading, volunteers will then select 12 essays per grade, 3 in each category. Up to 156 essay finalists and their "dads" will be invited to attend the IFI Faces of Fatherhood Celebrationtm in May 2017.

2. The "dads" of the essay finalists will receive questionnaires to complete and return.

3. Of those who fill out the questionnaire, the top 12 will be invited to the 2017 IFI Fatherhood Dinner Celebration in June 2017.

RULES:

1. One entry per person. All essays must be original, written in English, and created by the student. Teachers may translate the essays into English. Entries may be typed.

2. All entries become the property of Illinois Fatherhood Initiative (IFI).

3. Entry into the contest transfers copyright of the essay to IFI and grants IFI permission to reproduce without compensation all or any portion of the essay and response on an unlimited, world wide basis in its publications. When appropriate, IFI will cite the name of the author(s) if significant portions of a positive essay/response are used. IFI will also change or conceal names to maintain confidentiality where necessary.

4. Contest is open to Illinois residents, except employees of the Chicago White Sox, the Illinois Fatherhood Initiative, and it's Board of Directors and it's Board of Advisors, their respective affiliated companies or members of their respective families.

5. Taxes on any prizes awarded are the sole responsibility of winners. Prize winners, and their parents or guardians if the prize winner is a minor, must execute and return an affidavit of eligibility and liability/publicity release within twenty (20) days or prize will be awarded to an alternate. Offer subject to federal, state, and local regulations and laws and void where taxed, restricted, or prohibited. By entering, participants agree to the use of name, photograph, or likeness for advertising and similar promotions of the Chicago White Sox and Illinois Fatherhood Initiative without compensation.

CHECKLIST:

1. Photocopy the Essay Entry Form (#5), pages E-F, and give to students to use to write their essays. Please type in the school information on page F before photocopying. Students may use another piece of paper and type their essays only if they include the contact information that is listed at the top of the Essay Entry Form. To ensure that all essays are read, we need the essays to be submitted in English. Please translate the essay to English. Staple sheets together with the #5 Official Essay Contest Entry Form on top. Check to see if the student's name, school name, and grade is listed on the top of each page. It is very important to be able to identify each essay.

2. The essays must be postmarked by March 15, 2017. Feel free to send them in early.

3. After the essays are written make sure that every student has a photocopy of their essay to take to their father/father figure to compete. This step is important to fulfill a main goal of the essay contest, which is to make every effort to see these essays are shared with fathers and families

4. Set a deadline for your students to return their Father/Father Figure response to you that gives you plenty of time to comply with the March 15th deadline.

5. When all the essays are completed, place this sheet on the top of the essays from your class. Please do not put your essays in an envelope or folder.

6. Give the completed packet of essays to your school's Contact Person who will be responsible for mailing all of the essays from your school in one shipment. Do not mail your classroom's essays by themselves. Since we have 400+ schools participating, it is very important that we receive only one mailing from your school.

7. When the awards arrive, please distribute one set of awards to each student who participated from your classroom. IFI will mail the awards to the Contact Person from your school and they will be responsible for getting these awards to each teacher. *Please make and keep a list of participating students so every student who wrote an essay will get an award*.
